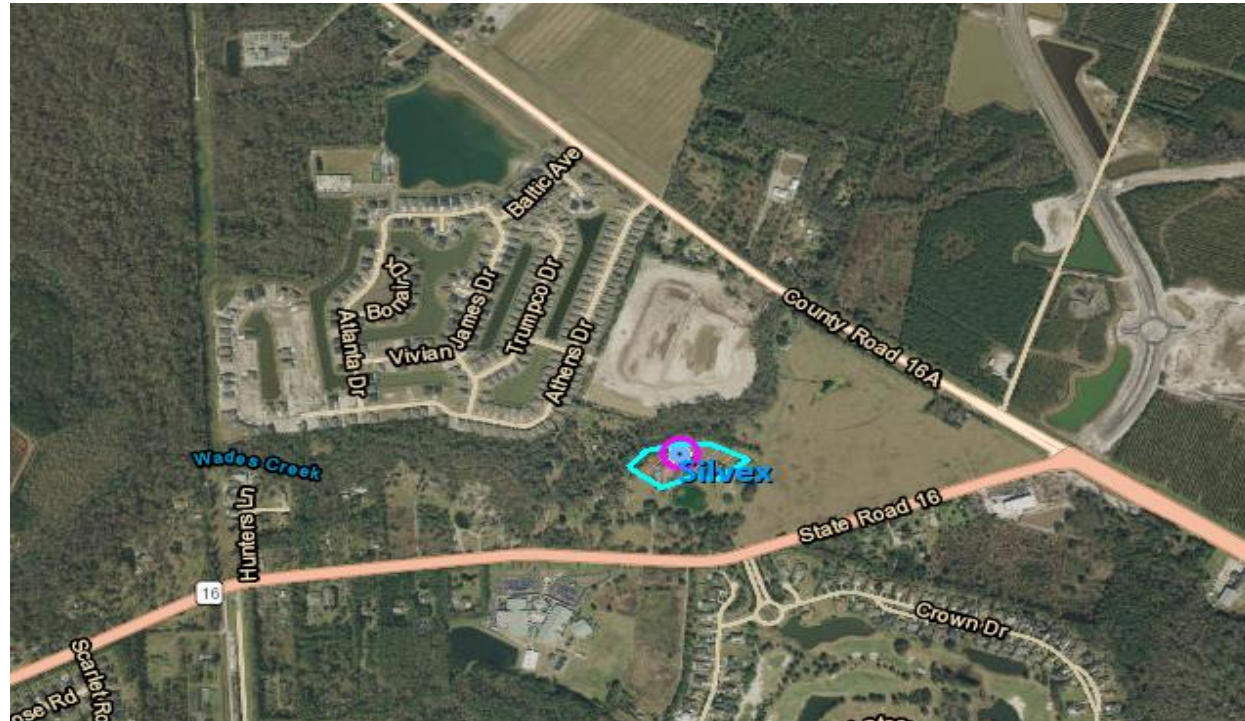


Water Well Permitting Requirements in St. Johns County, Effective September 11, 2020

St. Johns Co./ Greater than or equal to 6 inches	A District permit is required for all wells 6 inches or larger in diameter at land surface, regardless of use type or location. A District permit is also required for any gang well (two or more wells coupled together) when the total nominal casing sizes equal 6 inches or greater.
